



**Atlantis University Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA)/ Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II).**

**CRRSAA/HEERF II Student Share Grant**

Atlantis University was awarded funding for students. This funding is allocated to the Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund II (HEERF II), by the Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSAA).

Under CRRSAA, HEERF II Student Share Grant funds may be used for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care), or child care.

The CRRSAA requires that institutions **prioritize students with exceptional need** and has extended eligibility to students enrolled exclusively in distance education.

Students must apply for consideration and funds will be awarded on an ongoing basis until exhausted. Eligible expenses include food, housing, utilities, course materials, technology, health care, child care, and moving.
